As we prepare to start the new dance school year, the health and safety of our students, parents, staff, and teachers remains our highest priority! We have spent a lot of time in thoughtful preparation to (1) orient ourselves with the rules and guidelines set forth by the CDC and Maryland Department of Health and (2) using this information to execute the highest standard of care by putting plans and systems in place to minimize risk, keep our BDT family safe and healthy, and keep our dance school operational during this continued COVID-19 environment.

DANCE SAFE PLAN



DANCER DROP OFF

Park and walk your dancer to the door to complete the health survey. Level 1 and above dancers will be directed to their classroom. PreDancers will have indoor drop off.



WAITING AREA IS CLOSED

In order to comply with capacity guidelines, our waiting area is closed and only accessible to students and staff. You may drop off and pick up your dancer at the front door.



FACE MASKS

Dancers are required to wear a mask at all times. Teachers will have breaks for the dancers to get water as needed. All teachers and staff are required to wear a mask at all times. We will provide a mask if a dancer arrives without one.



CONTACTLESS HEALTH SURVEY

Students will be checked in by staff and parents will be asked to complete a brief health survey. Teachers and staff are also required to complete the health survey.



CONTACTLESS TEMPERATURE CHECK

All students, staff, and teachers are checked as they enter the building.



HAND SANITIZER

Hand sanitizer will be provided by Baltimore DanceTech. Dancers, staff, and teachers will be asked to sanitize their hands upon entering and exiting the building. Hand Sanitizer stations will be available throughout the building for all.



LIMITED CAPACITY

Class size is limited. Options for Distance Dance (virtual) and in-person instruction is available.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

Dancers are asked to stay apart in the hallways and classrooms. Floor markers are in place in the halls and classrooms to indicate safe distances.



SANITATION PROGRAM

All equipment, high touch surfaces, and bathrooms will be sanitized after each class using CDC approved disinfectants. A deep cleaning will be done at the end of the day to ensure that we are in compliance with all CDC and Maryland Department of Health protocols.
